Considerations

There are a couple of things to consider when preparing for your Bottom Dwellers performance. The band uses high-powered electrical equipment. Well, not too high powered, but bare in mind that they will need access to a **grounded** outlet or two in which to plug in their amps and PA system. Grounding is important to prevent microphone lip shock (it really hurts).

Keep the Bottom Dwellers out of direct sunlight and in a dry area. If the performance will be outside, you will find that the band performs much better when provided with a shaded area to play. A helpful tip for evening performances: To maximise both audience and Bottom Dwellers comfort, set the performance area up so that neither the band nor the audience is facing directly into the sun.
